#19 Lady Chaps, Chaparrals Entertain Clarendon College in Final Home Game of Season

While the post season fortunes of the Midland College Lady Chaps are sealed, having earned a spot in the upcoming NJCAA Region V Basketball Championships (Lubbock, TX February 6-9th) the Chap men are hanging by the thinnest of threads heading into Monday's final home game and a trip to NMJC next Thursday.

In the current WJCAC standings the MC Lady Chaps 22-6 (10-2) are tied with rival Odessa College for the top spot in the race for the conference title and the top seed in the Region V Tournament. Midland College and Odessa College are a game ahead of South Plains College and New Mexico Junior College. OC only has one conference game left to play, Monday at New Mexico JC, while the Lady Chaps, South Plains College and NMJC each have two games remaining in the regular season.

On the men's side Howard College, Odessa College and New Mexico Junior College each currently sit in a tie for first place, while South Plains College and the Chaparrals remain one game behind in the standings. The top four teams in the WJCAC advance to the Region V Tournament, so the Chaps narrowly hold a ticket to the dance and will need to win their final two regular season games and have some help along the way in order to qualify for the post season. The Chaparrals are 18-7 overall

and 9-5 in the WJCAC going into Monday's home contest with Clarendon College and a make or break game at New Mexico JC on Thursday.
